### From the Handicap Chair.....

Definitions: <u>Course Rating</u> – The mark that indicates the evaluation of the playing difficulty of a course for a *scratch golfer* under normal conditions based on yardage and other obstacles that affect scoring ability. <u>Slope Rating</u> – The measurement of the relative difficulty of a course for players who are not scratch golfers. A golf course of standard playing difficulty has a Slope Rating of 113. *Peggy K*.

#### UNDERSTANDING THE RULES OF GOLF
