In case you missed it: Laura Davies won the inaugural U.S. Senior Women's Open by 10 shots. By all measurements, the Tournament was a great success! Laura Davies of England took a five-stroke lead into the final round at Chicago Golf Club in Wheaton, Ill., and turned it into a victory lap. Davies, 54, a World Golf Hall of Fame member, posted a bogey-free round of five-under par 68 on Sunday to win by 10 over another Hall of Famer, 58-year-old Juli Inkster. Davies' 72-hole score was 16-under par 276, while Inkster finished at six-under par 286.

Both Davies and Inkster have remained active on the LPGA, playing 12 and nine events, respectively, this year. Laura still ranks 28th on the LPGA in driving distance, at nearly 262 yards.
